



GENERAL SAFETY TIPS

- Always carry your keys and keep them safe. Never give your keys to anyone else.
- Be aware of strangers on the premises. If you're not sure who someone is, please feel free to alert the staff.
- Always lock your door when you're going out and keep it closed at all times even if you are just nipping to the kitchen/bathroom.
- If you see anything suspicious, report it to staff as soon as possible.
- If your room is at ground level or easily accessible from the ground, make sure your windows are shut before you go out. Windows will only tilt outwards and should not open fully.
 - If any firedoors are faulty please report this to staff.

PREVENTION MEASURES

For safety reasons, our detection devices are highly sensitive and can be triggered by smoke, excessive steam or even aerosols. Close bathroom doors when showering. Never leave cooking unattended and always


ventilate the area with the cooker hood and open windows. Smoking, vaping, naked or covered flames and deep fat frying are not permitted.

FIRE SAFETY

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



IDENTIFY YOUR FIRE ASSEMBLY POINT





IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE



Raise the alarm and inform reception or the fire brigade without delay.

- Always treat all alarms as serious if they sound for longer than 60 seconds
- Evacuate the building as quickly as possible
- Make sure your flat mates have heard the alarm
- Make your way quickly to the fire assembly point
- Do not re-enter the building until it has been declared safe to do so

FIRE EQUIPMENT

Emergency equipment is in place for the safety of all residents. The tampering of emergency equipment, be it Fire Alarms or emergency exits (wedging open flat doors), is a serious offence which not only puts your flat mate's lives at risk and makes your insurance invalid but is also a criminal act. As such this will be subject to disciplinary action by the Warden, which may result in heavy fines and the risk of eviction from your accommodation. Please observe all procedures in respect of this.

FIRE ALARM TEST




Fire alarms will be tested on a weekly basis every Thursday. You will not have to evacuate the building unless the alarm continues to sound for more than 60 seconds. In this case follow the evacuation procedures to the assembly point.



FIRE DOORS SHOULD REMAIN CLOSED AT ALL TIMES AND SHOULD NOT BE WEDGED OPEN, DOING SO WILL POSE A SERIOUS SECURITY AND FIRE RISK. SHOULD YOU BECOME AWARE OF A FIRE OR A HAZARD THAT COULD DEVELOP INTO A FIRE, PLEASE CONTACT RECEPTION IMMEDIATELY.



LAUNDRY



Our main laundry is located next to the Reception.

All of the laundry rooms operate on the circuit laundry plus app (red and blue logo).

The app connects to the machine via Bluetooth and will give you a timer for your wash/dry so you know when its finished.

All laundries are £3.50 to wash and £1.50 to dry.

BIKE STORAGE



We have multiple bike storage areas across site. Please come to the reception to register and get a tag for your bike.

You will then be given access via your block acess card. Only students using the bike sheds have access.

Bike storage is free to all students.

POST AND PARCELS



Each flat has a shared mailbox which Royal
Mail can access for delivery of letters and
small parcels. Always include a contact
number for packages so delivery
drivers can contact you.

For delivery to our Reception Amazon locker, add 'Vine' to your address book. If the UniDrop multi courier parcel locker has been used for your deliveries you will be notifed by text.

PARKING



Parking permits are available for £300 per year.


